The <u>Emerging Minds</u> network would like to invite you to a meeting hosted by Professor Deborah Chambers of Newcastle University.

Emerging Minds is a mental health research network funded by UK Research & Innovation (UKRI) with the aim of encouraging research across sectors and disciplines. We want to reduce the prevalence of mental health problems amongst children and young people through mental health promotion, prevention and early treatment.

The Emerging Minds network has a fund of £500,000 to share to enable research collaborations. We have prioritised 4 <u>research challenges</u> from the questions that young people, families, practitioners and policy makers have told us were most important and pressing. The purpose of this meeting is to kick start the next stage of the project.

The objectives of the event are to:

- To share more detail about the Emerging Minds <u>funding calls</u> to be launched in autumn 2019.
- To showcase some inspiring examples of relevant research
- Facilitate discussions around possible collaborations to address the Emerging Minds research challenges.

We will also be highlighting the opportunities offered by the 7 other UKRI funded mental health research networks.
