The <u>Emerging Minds</u> network would like to invite you to a meeting hosted by Andrea Taylor, Research Fellow within the School of Design at the Glasgow School of Art.

Emerging Minds is a mental health research network funded by UK Research & Innovation (UKRI) with the aim of encouraging research across sectors and disciplines. We want to reduce the prevalence of mental health problems amongst children and young people through mental health promotion, prevention and early treatment.

The Emerging Minds network has a fund of £500,000 to share to enable research collaborations. We have prioritised 4 <u>research challenges</u> from the questions that young people, families, practitioners and policy makers have told us are most important and pressing. The purpose of this meeting is to kick start the next stage of the project.

The objectives of the event are:

- To share more detail about the Emerging Minds <u>funding calls</u> to be launched in autumn 2019.
- To showcase inspiring examples of relevant research.
- To facilitate discussions around possible collaborations to address the Emerging Minds <u>research challenges</u>.

We will also be highlighting the opportunities offered by the <u>TRIUMPH network</u> and the other UKRI funded mental health research networks.
